#### PART-1

#### BRIEF HISTORY AND PAST PERFORMANCE

- (a) Brief description of forests and forestry sector in the State:
  - i) Forest and tree cover in Delhi: Delhi is one of the Greenest Cities in the country having 20.59% of its total geographical area under green cover. As per the State of Forest Report 2017 published by FSI, Green Cover of Delhi has increased from 299.77 sq km (20.21 %) in 2015 to 305.41 sq km (20.59%) in 2017.
  - ii) Legal status of various forests: The Forest areas in Delhi include the following:
    - Reserved Forest: An area of 7784 ha was notified as Reserve Forest under section 4 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927. It comprises of Northern Ridge, Southern Ridge, Central Ridge, South-Central Ridge.
    - Protected Forests: Delhi has 1658 ha under PF.
    - Morphological Ridge area: The Hon'ble Supreme Court has declared the morphological ridge which is Aravalli outcrop in NCT of Delhi to be maintained in its pristine glory and accordingly had directed Ridge Management Board to be constituted for the purpose under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary. Any non-forestry activity in this area attracts Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Before proceeding for clearance under FCA, approval of Ridge Management Board and Central Empowered Committee of Hon'ble Supreme Court is needed. It is also maintained as conservation reserve.
    - Other forests: a) Old City Forests: There are thirteen old city forests maintained by the Department, namely, at Nasirpur (28.00 Ha.), Alipur (19.50 Ha.), Hauzrani (28.80 Ha.), Mitraon (40.00 Ha.), Sultanpur (48.00 Ha.), Ghumenhera (32.00 Ha.), Ghoga (10.40 Ha.), Shahapur Garhi (08.00 Ha.), Mamurpur (56.00 Ha.), Jindpur (47.60 Ha.), Mukhmelpur (53.00 Ha.), Bawana (32.00 Ha.) and Garhi Mandu (300.00 Ha. b) New City Forests (2007-08): The Department has undertaken creation of nine new city forests during 2007-08 at Issapur (66.25 Ha.), Rewla Khanpur (22.85 Ha.), Kharkhari Jatmal (50.00 Ha.), Sultanpur Dabbas (24.76 Ha.),

Mungeshpur (13.5 Ha.), Qutabgarh (27.77 Ha.), Hindon Cut Ghazipur (9.33 Ha.), Harewali (24.80 Ha.) and Mukhmelpur (19.43 Ha.). c) New City Forests (2008-09): During 2008-09, the Department had undertaken development of nine new city forests, namely, at Rewla Khanpur (20 Acre), Shikarpur, (109 Acre), Rajokhari, (15.5 Acre), Nazafgarh Drain (29.64 Acre), Qutubgarh, (20 Acre), Mukhmelpur, (13Acre), Raj Vidya Kendra, Sahurpur (37Acre), Aya Nagar (25Acre) and Burari Bund (8 km. of the slope of Burari Bund Road towards supplementary drain).

- Protected Area: A part of southern Ridge is notified as Asola WL in 1986 and as Bhatti WL Sanctuary in 1991. One village 'Bhatti' falls under Bhatti WL Sanctuary and is yet to be translocated.
- iii) **Type of forests in Delhi**: As per Champion and Seth classification (1968) two types of broad categories of forests can be found as Tropical thorn forest and tropical dry deciduous forests.
- (b) Compensatory afforestation, other forestry and related schemes (physical and financial) including catchment area treatment, wildlife management and community development works and activities carried out therein in the State in last five years from the State Fund:

Since 1980, an area of 117.582 ha has been diverted under FCA, 1980 under 23 no. of proposals approved by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India as on 31.09.2019. Progress of CA and allied activities in last 05 years is placed in **Annexure A**.

(c) Forestry and other related schemes (physical and financial) and activities carried out therein in the state in previous years from the fund received under other schemes of the Government in tabular form.

The state receives plan fund from the state government as well as carries out plantation from proceeds of civil deposits received under Delhi Tree Preservation Act (DPTA), 1994.

A tabulated statement shows the plantation done from State plan and DPTA is annexed as annexure B.

(d) Year wise total forest area diverted in the various districts/ forest divisions of the State since 1980, in tabular form.

Since 1980, an area of 117.582 ha has been diverted under FCA, 1980 under 25 no. of proposals approved by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India as on 31.05.2019 as per details in **Annexure C**.

## (e) Year wise total compensatory afforestation carried out in the State since 1980, in tabular form.

An area of 128.5746 Ha has been brought under compensatory afforestation since 1980 as per **Annexure D**.

## (f) Brief description and abstract of the monitoring work done by the Monitoring and Evaluation Wing of the State Forest Department:

The Department has one dedicated post of DCF for the purpose for forests of Delhi and is designated as Protection and Monitoring. The NCT of Delhi has peculiar advantage of being monitored and scrutinized extensively and minutely for all forestry works as the public in general is extremely aware of the significance of forests and concerned about environment.

# (g) Brief description and abstract of the monitoring work done by the independent monitor (Third Party Monitoring) in the State:

The area of NCT of Delhi falls under the jurisdiction of Regional Office (Central Zone), Lucknow of MoEF&CC and there is periodic visit of the representative of the Regional Office to inspect the areas diverted and areas where Compensatory afforestation is done. The Department has also written to the Forest Research Institute, Dehradun to conduct inspection of the afforested areas.

The APO for the year 2019-20 has been prepared on the basis of the Physical and Financial achievement during the previous years. Out of Rs 1321.8 lakhs proposed outlay, Rs. 717.8 lakhs is a committed liability consisting of provisions for maintaining previous years' plantation and raising of new CA plantation proposed to be carried out in 2019-20. It also includes part where work is already executed over 100 ha of CA plantation and 100 ha of plantation under NPV fund in ETF area in 2017-18 and payments to the tune of 149 lakhs. **Annexure E.**

#### Part-II:

Activities to be undertaken for compensatory afforestation, additional compensatory afforestation, penal compensatory afforestation, catchment area treatment plan and for any other site specific scheme may be used as per site-specific schemes submitted by the State along with the approved proposals for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 (69 of 1980) referred to in clause (a) of section 6 of the Act:

(a) District/ forest division wise details of new compensatory afforestation, catchment area treatment plan works, wildlife management activities to be done as per the conditions imposed under forest clearance granted by the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is attached as **annexure H**:

Only CA is proposed to be created during the year 2019-20 over an area of 50.408 ha against 07 projects diverted in the year 2017-18 and 2018-2019 and 2019-20. Cost of creation has been worked out as Rs. 504 Lakhs.

No work is proposed against PCA, CAT plan and other site specific activity as same was not required/submitted during approval of the proposal.

(b) Location, estimated cost and implementation schedule of each activity proposed to be executed from State CA Fund to be provided district / division wise is attached as annexure I

The creation of CA is proposed to be done at CA area earmarked at 'Yamuna bank metro station and parking line' under North Forest Division. One CA patch is proposed in West Forest Division over an area of 0.99 ha and in one case CA plantation is to be done in South Forest Division at the site of diversion.

- (c) Details of maintenance works in physical and financial terms proposed to be undertaken in the current financial year in the case of compensatory afforestation work, catchment area treatment plan works, wildlife management activities and other such activities undertaken in previous years which need maintenance for its survival and sustainability as annexure J and J 1.
  - a) Maintenance proposed for the year 2019-20:
    During 2015-16, CA was created over an area of 7.6649 ha against 05 no. of projects. It is to be taken up for 4<sup>th</sup> year maintenance. During 2015-16 again, CA over an area of 19.9446 ha was created. It is to be taken up for 4<sup>th</sup> year maintenance during current APO. Total cost for the purpose is Rs143. lakhs. (Annex J)

b) Maintenance already carried out in 2017-18:

Expenses already incurred for maintenance of CA plantation over 100 ha of plantation done in ETF area at Bhatti under South Forest Division in the year 2011-12 costing Rs. 70.8 lakhs are also proposed for approval. (Annex J1)

#### **PART-III:**

### ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN FROM NET PRESENT VALUE AND INTEREST COMPONENT REFERRED IN RULE 5 AND RULE 6:

## (a) <u>District/ forest division wise details of activities to be done in the State on specified</u> activities referred to in rule 5 and rule 6

#### <u>NPV</u>.

The proposal for utilization of interest accrued on deposit pertains to off set increment increase in cost of CA, maintenance of office establishment, Hiring of vehicle, etc. The following activities are proposed to be carried out in the state from the funds received under NPV. The details are mentioned in annexure K.

#### i) Modernisation of forest nurseries:

The survival of plantation largely depends on the quality of planting material used. All the nurseries of the forest department are required to be modernized since these play a critical role in providing quality plat material. The use of facilities such as micro-sprinklers, drip irrigation, agro-poly net houses, mist chambers, construction of water storage tanks, compost pits, procurement of root trainers etc for development of hi-tech nursery is proposed.

It is proposed to develop 01 hi-tech nursery at Garhi Mandu under North Forest Division during the APO 2019-20 at the cost of Rs. 35.00 lakhs.

#### ii) Soil and moisture conservation activities:

Conservation of water is of acute necessity in the context of Delhi. To enhance availability of water in plantation area and to create system for recharging of natural aquifers it is proposed to create 02 water bodies in North Forest Division at CA land in Shastri Park and Bela Farms. An amount of Rs. 75 lakhs is proposed. Similarly in South Forest Division, there is requirement of 03 water bodies @ Rs. 35 each.

West Forest Division has proposed to carry out soil and moisture conservation works by creating one water body in Rajokri at cost of Rs. 10 lakhs and plantation around it of grasses costing Rs. 3 lakhs and trees and shrubs costing Rs. 3 lakhs also. A check dam is also proposed at cost of Rs. 3 lakhs.

#### iii) Proposal for wildlife conservation and Management:

A large no. of wild animals are reported to be injured in Delhi due to high mananimal conflict. It is proposed to upgrade the facility at Rajokri in South Forest Division and develop it as state of the art rescue centre for wildlife. An amount of Rs. 1.25 crore is proposed for the purpose of creating infrastructure and a veterinary doctor is proposed to be hired @ Rs. 50,000/- per month. Two no. of animal rescue vehicle is also proposed @ 10 lakhs. 06 Animal handlers are also to be taken on contract @ Rs. 25,000 pm. Besides, estimation of wildlife population is required to be done through reputed organization (WII) in the subject. An amount of Rs.15 lakhs is proposed for the same. Rs. 20 lakh is proposed for establishing Wildlife helpline and intelligence system. An amount of Rs. 20 lakhs is also proposed for carrying out wildlife research through WII.

#### iv) Construction of watch towers:

Since most of the topography where the plantations are raised are either flat lands or undulating, hence it is desirable to have a birds eye-view of the same through watch towers. Hence it is proposed to have 07 watch towers in the plantation areas at an estimated cost of 29 lakhs.

#### v) Maintenance of 100 ha plantation created through NPV

6<sup>th</sup> year maintenance was done over 100 ha of plantation created in 2012-13 for an amount of Rs. 78 lakhs in the year 2017-18 is also incorporated for seeking ex-post facto approval.

#### vi) Preparation of Working Plan

Working Plan for Delhi is proposed to be written for Delhi through FRI at an estimated cost of Rs. 78 akhs.

#### **INTEREST ACCRUED ON DEPOSITS:**

As per Rule 6 of the CAF Rules 2018, interest accrued on the amount available in the state fund can be utilized for non-recurring expenditure of the State Authority with the approval of the Steering Committee. Following activities are proposed:

#### i) Hiring of personnels' on Contract basis/deputation:

There is no regular/contractual staff in the State Authority for conducting day to day business. Therefore services of the office staff such as Asst Accounts Officer, Section Officer, Asst Consultant, Data entry operator (DEO), IT personnel to manage

e-green watch, MTS etc are required to be hired on contract basis or deputation. An expenditure of Rs 20 lakhs is proposed to be spent on the purpose. **Annexure L**.

#### ii) Hiring of vehicle:

There is no vehicle/staff car with the State Authority. Therefore, it is proposed to hire one car for CEO of the state CAMPA. An amount of Rs. 5.00 lakh is proposed.

#### iii) Management of office establishment:

An amount of Rs. 10 lakhs is proposed for office expenses for the state authority and for preparation of various reports such as annual report, hiring of CA, fee of members etc.

#### iv) Third party monitoring for works carried out from CAMPA funds:

It is proposed to hire the services of Forest Research Institute, Dehradun for the purpose and an amount of Rs. 10 lakhs is proposed.

#### v) Provision to offset the incremental cost of CA at the increased wage rate.

The cost norm for the plantations proposed in the APO is based on the prevailing wage rate. To offset the incremental cost of plantations, a provision of Rs. 20 lakhs (5%) is proposed.

(b) Location, estimated cost and implementation schedule of each activity proposed to be executed from State Fund to be provided district / division wise.

Only establishment components are mentioned hence, not applicable.

(C) Details of maintenance works in physical and financial terms, proposed to be undertaken in the current financial year in the case of activities undertaken in the State on specified activities referred to in rule 5 and rule 6 undertaken in previous years which needs maintenance for its survival and sustainability.
