I am directed to refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, **In-principle approval is hereby conveyed** for diversion of **1.53 hectares** of forest land for the above mentioned project, subject to the following conditions:

- i. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per the proposed scheme may be realized from the user agency;
- ii. Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be realized from the user agency, as per Ministry's directions issued vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 5th February 2009 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 30th October 2002, 28th March, 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008;
- iii. - iv. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India; and
- v. **A certificate in respect of complete settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, if any, on the forest land proposed to be diverted along with documentary evidence stipulated by this Ministry in its letter No. 11-09/1998-FC (pt) dated 3rd August, 2009, 5th February, 2013, and 5th July, 2013, as applicable to this project, be submitted;**
- vi. Equivalent non-forest land provided by the user agency for compensatory afforestation shall be handed over to the Forest Department and mutated in favour of Delhi Forest Department. The details of this non-forest land and mutation paper be submitted; and
- vii. The non-Forest land provided by the user agency shall be declared as Reserve Forest within two months from the date of issue of final approval under FCA,1980.

3. The compliance on the above may be submitted at the earliest. **The use of forest land will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.**

I am directed to refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, **In-principle approval is hereby conveyed** for diversion of **4.2309 hectares** of forest land for the above mentioned project, subject to the following conditions:

- i. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per the proposed scheme may be realized from the user agency;
 - ii. I am directed to refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, **"in-principle" approval is hereby conveyed** for diversion of **0.9 hectares** of forest land for the above mentioned project subject to the following conditions:

- i. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per the proposed scheme may be realized from the user agency;
- ii. Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be realized from the user agency, as per Ministry's directions issued vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 5th February 2009 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 30th October 2002, 28th March, 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008;
- iii. As per the orders of the Government of India vide letter No. 5-2/2010-CAMPA dated 24.06.2011, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land and all other CA levies shall be deposited in State specific CAMPA accounts maintained by the Ad-hoc CAMPA in New Delhi in "DELHI CAMPA" account No. SB01025206, Corporation Bank (Government of India Undertaking), Block -11, Ground Floor, CGO Complex, Phase-I Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110 003 or "DELHI CAMPA" Account No. SB 344902010105 415, Union Bank of India, Sunder Nagar, New Delhi and this office may be informed by duly filled in prescribed proforma;
- iv. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;
- v. Equivalent non-forest land provided by the user agency for compensatory afforestation shall be handed over to the Forest Department and mutated in favour of Delhi Forest Department. The details of this non-forest land and mutation paper be submitted;
- vi. The non-Forest land provided by the user agency shall be declared as Reserve Forest within three months from the date of issue of final approval under FCA, 1980.
- vii. All the funds received from the user agency under the project, except the funds realized for regeneration/demarcation of safety zone, shall be transferred to Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) in Saving Account pertaining to the State concerned;
- viii. **A certificate in respect of complete settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, if any, on the forest land proposed to be diverted along with documentary evidence stipulated by this Ministry in its letter No. 11-09/1998-FC (pt) dated 3rd August, 2009, 5th February, 2013, and 5th July, 2013, as applicable to this project, be submitted;**

3. The following conditions shall also be complied with after according final approval:
- i. Muck disposal should be taken up as per the scheme approved by the Forest Department;
 - ii. As recommended by the Geologist and Task Force, the required soil conservation measures should be taken up by the user agency for which fund should be provided as per the current rate of works;
 - iii. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;
 - iv. The User Agency shall pay additional amount of NPV, as and when increased on the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;
 - v. The User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;
 - vi. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
 - vii. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and shall, under no circumstances, be transferred to any one without approval of the Central Government;
 - viii. The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
 - ix. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground with four feet high cement concrete pillars with its serial number and forward & back bearing inscribed on it;
 - x. The User Agency shall ensure that because of this project, no damage is caused to the wildlife available in the area;
 - xi. The user agency in consultation with the State Government shall create and maintain alternate habitat/home for the avifauna, whose nesting trees are to be cleared in this project. Bird's nests artificially made out of eco-friendly material shall be used in the area, including forest area and human settlements, adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project;
 - xii. Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
 - xiii. The User agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above conditions to the State Government and to this Regional Office regularly;
 - xiv. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project; and
4. After receipt of the compliance report on fulfillment of the conditions under para-2 also, the proposal shall be considered for the final approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. **The use of forest land will not be allowed till final approval is accorded and environmental clearance, if any applicable, is obtained.**
